Police are continuing investigations into a fire at a North Sydney house this morning that has left four men and a dog in critical condition. Firefighters were called to Lincoln Road, near Hook Road in North Sydney, just after 8am. The blaze took 20 firefighters about 30 minutes to bring under control.
